Marine Reserve was established in 1992. There are rich and varied habitats within its boundaries and the Reserve is helping to restore, increase & maintain the diversity in this marine environment.

The vision is of a well managed reserve, bountiful in marine life, respected and enjoyed by the public for generations to come.

The marine reserve covers 9 square kilometers and is administered by the Department of Conservation in partnership with the Te Whanganui-A-Hei (Cathedral Cove) Marine Reserve Committee.
